## MCCURTAIN PUBLIC NOTICE

Farrell-Cooper Mining Company, P.O. Box 11050, Fort Smith, AR 72917, has applied to the Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement for a permit to mine coal by underground methods. Under the federal Indian lands program, permit OK-042F-CC essentially would be a reissue of permit 4285F that had been issued by the Oklahoma Department of Mines in March 2012. Permit OK-042F-CC (462 acres) would be within the Choctaw Nation Reservation in Sections 13, 14, and 15 of Township 8 North, Range 22 East, Haskell County, Oklahoma, as shown on the USGS 7.5-minute McCurtain quadrangle map. Underground workings plus the associated permit area would cover about 6,000 acres.

The permit area is in the watershed of Mule Creek and would be mined and reclaimed in accordance with federal coal regulations.
