Notice of Rescission

As a result of the settlement agreement in Save Our Cumberland Mountains, Inc., et al. v. Lujan, Directive INE-25, "Terminating Revised Parker Order Failure-to-Abate Cessation Orders", dated May 26, 1987, Transmittal Number 337, is obsolete.

Directive INE-25 was issued in response to the Revised Parker Order of Save Our Cumberland Mountains, Inc. et al. v. Clark, Civil Action No. 81-2134 (D.D.C.), which required the Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement to notify the plaintiffs prior to terminating any failure-to-abate cessation order which was in effect for more than 30 days and issued prior to February 1, 1985. Under the settlement agreement such plaintiff review is no longer required.

Therefore, Directive INE-25 is rescinded effective September 5, 1990, the date of court approval of the settlement agreement.
