Directive INE-40, Transmittal Number 600, dated March 1, 1990, is changed to modify the existing reporting requirements.

1. Section 5, "Reporting Requirements," is amended by revising Section 5 to read as follows:
5. Reporting Requirements.

The Field Assessment Units shall ensure that appropriate data is accurate, complete, and entered into CMIS in a timely manner. The AVS Office will produce from CMIS the quarterly ICP report as stated in Section 11.2(c) of the Settlement Agreement between Save Our Cumberland Mountains, Inc., et al., and Manuel Lujan, Jr., Secretary of the United States Department of the Interior, et al. The report will specify the name of every individual against whom OSM has assessed an ICP pursuant to section 518(f) of the Act, the amount of the penalty, the current status of the penalty, and the name of all individuals whom OSM has determined are ineligible for assessment of an ICP pursuant to section 518(f) of the Act.
