WHAT IS THE OSMRE AMERICORPS PROGRAM?

AmeriCorps programs do more than move communities forward; they serve their members by creating jobs and providing pathways to opportunity for young people entering the workforce. AmeriCorps places young adults into intensive service positions where they learn valuable work skills, earn money for education, and develop an appreciation for citizenship. These positions last for one year.

WHAT DO AMERICORPS MEMBERS RECEIVE?

In exchange for their service, AmeriCorps Members receive:

- Weekly living allowance
- Receive service-end education award
- The potential to obtain non-competitive eligibility for federal employment
- Student loan forbearance while serving
- Health benefits and childcare assistance
