

Blaster Certificates - Coal Mining States

Last updated: April 2017

The following States grant blaster certificates for coal mining. The states in **bold** recognize the OSMRE Blaster Certificate with an issued classification as meeting the minimum requirement for establishing technical competence in surface coal mining blasting. However, each blaster must still file an application, meet the administrative requirements and possibly take a short examination on local regulations in each state. Federal Program states/tribes that require an OSM Blaster certificate are: Arizona, California, Georgia, Idaho, Massachusetts, Michigan, North Carolina, Oregon, Rhode Island, South Dakota, Tennessee, Washington, Navajo and Crow.
