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TOPICS: PERMIT, ACREAGE AND INSPECTION FEES [Update of Report No. 17, (1984)]

INQUIRY: What are the permit application and acreage fees for the following states: Kentucky, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Virginia and West Virginia? Do these states charge inspection fees?

SEARCH RESULTS: The IMCC conducted a telephone survey of the five states listed above plus Illinois and Texas. The results presented in the attached table update State Comparison Report No. 17, prepared in 1984. A copy of Report No. 17 is included for reference.

TABLE OF FEES

STATE	INSPECTION FEES	PERMIT FEES	ACREAGE FEES
KENTUCKY	No	\$ 375 Permit application processing fee	\$ 75 Per acre.
ILLINOIS	No	--	\$ 125 Per bonded acre when overburden is removed. \$ 5 Per acre not actually mined. May be additional charges in special circumstances. No renewal fee.
OHIO	No	--	\$ 75 Per acre. There is a refund for areas not affected or disturbed. Fee was increased from \$ 50 in 1986.



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PENNSYLVANIA	No	\$ 250 Permit application fee.	\$ 50 Per bonded acre. May be additional charges, depending on the operation, e.g., if it will alter/obstruct a body of water.
TEXAS	No	\$ 5,000 Permit fee. \$ 500 Revision fee. \$ 3,000 Renewal fee.	\$ 120 Per acre of land which had coal or lignite actually removed during calendar year charged.
VIRGINIA	No	--	\$ 12 Per acre permitting fee. \$ 6 Per acre renewal fee.
WEST VIRGINIA	No	\$ 500 Quarry permit application filing fee. \$ 1,000 Fee for all other permit applications. \$ 500 Addition fee for NPDES permit if filed at the same time. \$ 2,000 Renewal fee. \$ 100 NPDES reissuance fee. \$ 500 Prospecting fee.	--
