1. **Purpose**

This Change Notice provides minor revisions to Directive GMT-10, Federal Assistance Manual (FAM), issued August 15, 2019. The revisions fulfill the corrective actions identified in Recommendations 4 and 9 in the Office of Inspector General's (OIG) Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement's (OSMRE) Oversight of the Abandoned Mine Lands Program (Report No. 2016-EAU-007).

2. <u>Summary of Changes</u>

The revisions clarify that both coal and non-coal reclamation projects require the use of Authorizations to Proceed (ATPs) pursuant to 30 CFR 885.16(e) (Recommendation 4) and clarify how to collect and track engineering and design project costs with new subaccounts (Recommendation 9). A summary of the changes for each chapter is included below:
